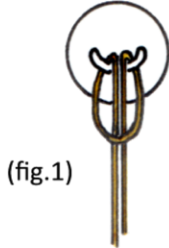


# DOUBLE WRAP BRACELET



**Supplies needed:**  
 Shank style Button | 10-15mm dia.  
 C-Lon Micro Cord | 3 yds  
 1.5mm round Leather Cord | 1 meter or ±39"  
 4mm Firepolish | ±30-40  
 8/0 Seed Beads | ±4 grams  
 Clip Board - Scissors - Super Glue - Tape

A variety of different Beads can be used in this project! 6/0 Seed Beads w/ 11/0 Seed Beads - Tila Beads

The First Step:

Carefully trim the ends of C-Lon Micro cord. Coat both ends w/ a thin quick drying super glue to the ends of the thread (approx 1-1.25") to create stiff (self-needle) ends. Allow to dry by hanging.

Fold Micro Cord in half. Feed ends thru shank of button, then thru the loop - pull tight to form a Lark's Head Knot. (fig.1)

Feed one end of Leather Cord thru shank of button. Fold in half. Tie an overhand knot around the Micro Cord. (fig.2) Position knot next to edge of button. Pull overhand knot flat and tight. Arrange Micro Cord to come up thru the center of Leather Cords. (fig.3)

Position button shank side up under Clip Board's clip. Insert a spacer of some sort if needed to prevent the Leather Cord from being compressed by the clip.

Smooth and untwist Leather Cord to lay flat. Tie an overhand knot close to the ends of the Leather Cord. Wrap to the underside of the clip board and tape down. Do not pull Leather Cord too tight - just snug. There should not be any tension stretching Leather Cord.

You are ready to begin adding Beads!

Grab Micro Cord - split one side in each hand. Wrap thread over the top, around, and up thru the center of the Leather Cords. Always make sure you do this step before adding any Beads! (fig.4)

Add a Bead by running thread thru each side of the Bead(s) over to the opposite side. Pull Micro Cord snug(!) to position Bead(s) into place. Position bead(s) just next to each other (don't crowd them in too tight) or they will start to buckle when wrapped around your wrist. (fig.4)

Repeat the last 2 steps until desired length of bracelet is reached. To determine length needed, take your wrist measurement (loosely) and double that length. The measurement will determine the total length of the Beads to be added between the starting and ending knots at each end of the bead work.

To finish, bring your thread around over and up thru the center of the Leather Cords one last time. Tie in a triple knot. Add a small drop of glue. Remove your work from the clip board. Untie the knot at the ends of the Leather Cord. Tie an over-hand knot around the Micro Cord as before positioned next to last Bead added. Pull tight. Trim Micro Cord close to the bottom of this knot.

Add another overhand knot enough distance from the first knot to allow the Button to pass thru. Trim the Leather Cord ends to the desired length (about a 1/2" or so). (fig.5) CONGRATULATIONS!
